

KAWAIHAE HARBOR

Kawaihae Harbor's basin measures some 1,450 feet by 1,500 feet with a depth of 35 feet. The entrance channel is 3,270-feet long, 500-feet wide and 40-feet deep. A 2,650-foot breakwater protects the harbor. Pier 2 and Kawaihae Harbor's main pier and it provides 1,150 feet of berthing space with water depths of 35 feet.


